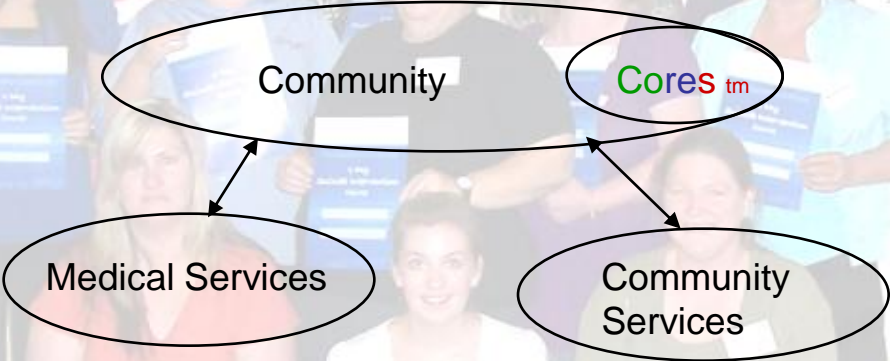
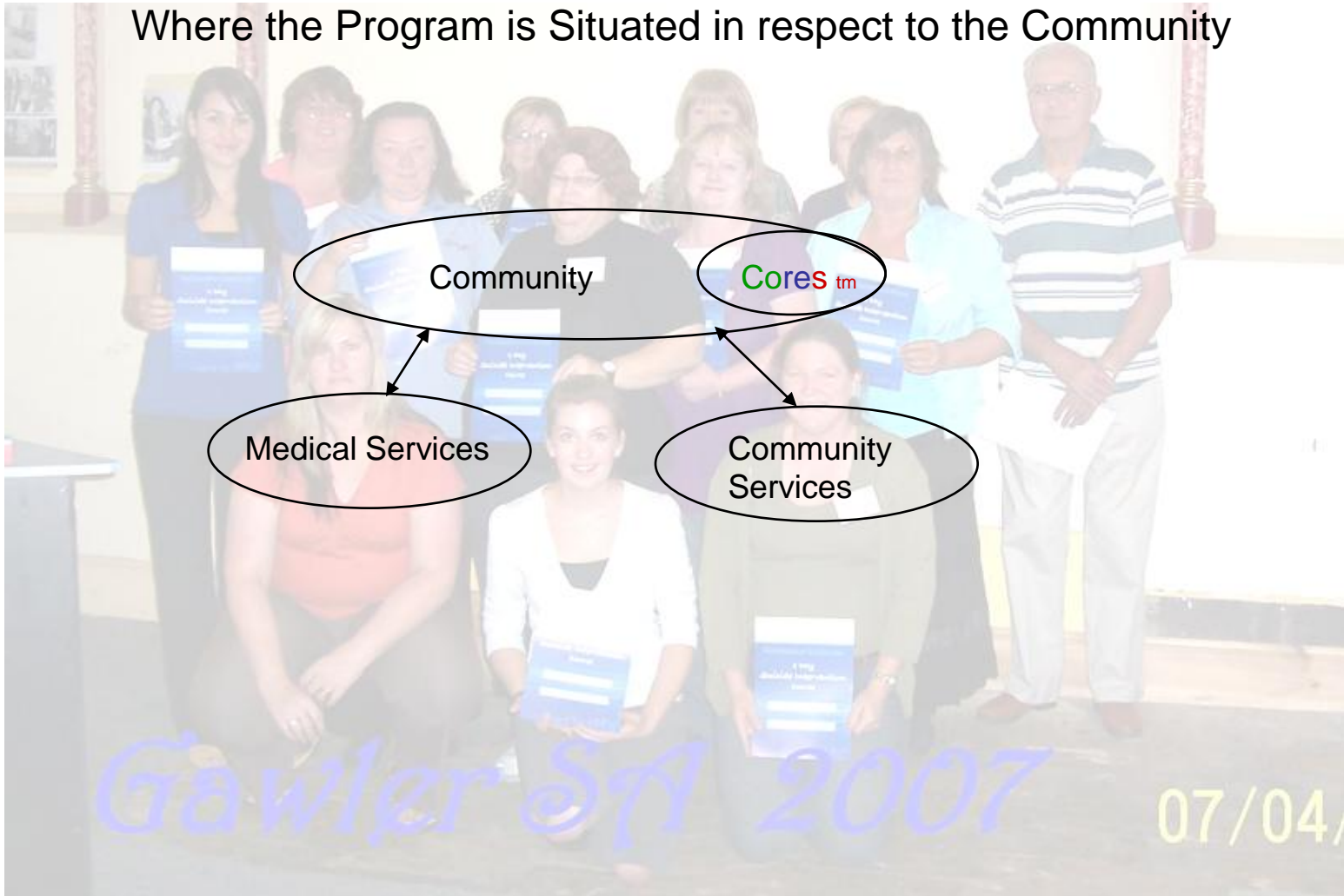

How does the Program Work?

- It engages people in the community no matter what their backgrounds may be and presents material in a simple to understand format.
- The program provides those in the community with a pathway to involvement in suicide prevention and skills them in being able to take this to the remainder of the community.
- It empowers local communities to recognize the signs of suicide and intervene before a crisis occurs and the courage to refer onto appropriate services.





The Eleven CORE Principles of the Program

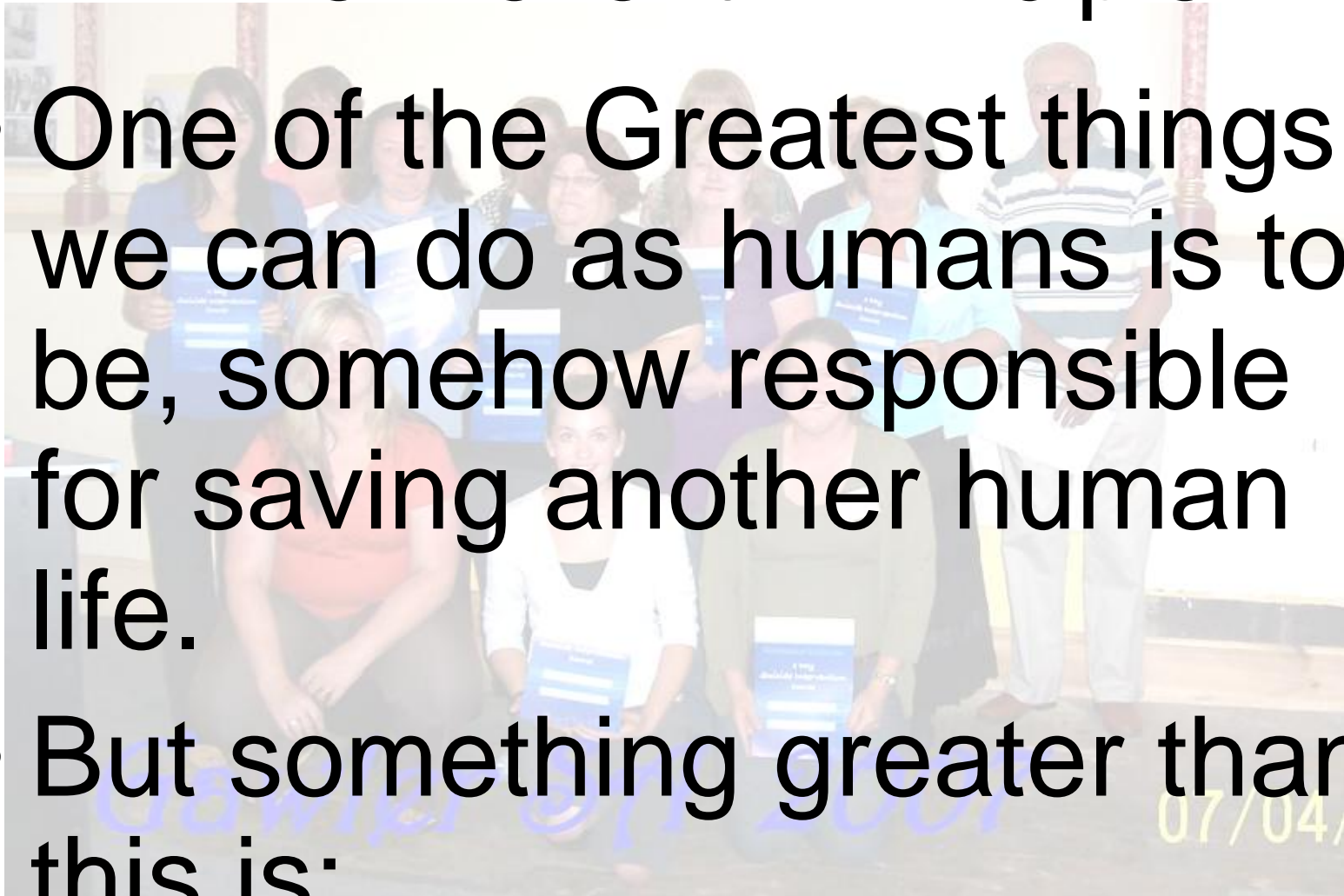
- 1 There has to be a **S**ENSE of Community.
 - 2 Communities have to **W**ANT the program.
 - 3 Communities have **O**WNSHIP of their direction and outcomes.
 - 4 Communities are the **O**RIGINATORS of their own capacity and inclusion.
 - 5 Communities are **P**REPARED to participate.


The Eleven CORE Principles of the Program

- 
- 6 KRC is not a Service Provider.
 - 7 Communities are not made up of clients, customers or consumers.
 - 8 Communities are made up of people who are willing to take action.
 - 9 Therefore, as KRC does not have any clients, customers or consumers, it works with people in a unique relationship.
 - 10 It doesn't matter if KRC no longer exists, what has been passed on, can and will live on into the future, championed by people in the community.
