Systemic practice, today, is more and more challenged by cases that are characterised by a peculiar complexity, due both to specific individual issues, and to the complicated network of institutions and practices that usually surrounds them. Systemic understanding may have a key role in helping professionals deal with such complexities.

This 2 day workshop aims at helping experienced professionals to develop the abilities necessary to better understand the restraints and possibilities involved in such cases and through a comprehensive analysis of the situation, their own position within it.

KEY CONTENT AREAS

DAY 1: BASIC SKILLS

This Sessions will cover the skills a professional should develop in order to work efficiently with complex cases.

DAY 2: CASE SUPERVISION

This day will be entirely devoted to team case supervisions, in order to help teams to work in a systemic way through practice.

The principles outlined here will be put into practice using role-play and case supervisions, for which the participants will be encouraged to bring their own clinical cases.
