The 'Safe from the Start' project was an innovative action research study, conducted by Dr Angela Spinney for The Salvation Army, investigating the effects of family violence on young children, aged 0-6 years, and how the negative impact of such experiences can be reduced.

As a result of the study a kit of simple materials has been developed for use by children's workers and parents with young children who have experienced family violence or trauma, including recommendations on methods of best practice when working with children from these circumstances.
